VILLAGE OF TWIN LAKES RESIDENTIAL REFUSE & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICES

Limited Refuse Collection Program: Service includes weekly curbside collection of household waste limited to a 95 gallon cart issued by Groot. Standard household waste placed out at the curb in excess of the refuse cart will not be collected. Should you require additional weekly service you may contact Groot direct for an additional garbage cart which will be made available for an annual rent-

Unlimited Recycling Collection Program: Service includes every other week curbside collection of recyclables with a 95 gallon cart issued by Groot. Recyclables placed out at the curb in addition to a full recycling cart will be collected at no additional charge. For details on the collection schedule please find a map enclosed. For a list of accepted recyclables please reference our recycling guide within this brochure.

Collection Time: Refuse and recycling is required to be out at the curb by 6:00 a.m. each week.

Bulk Item Collection: In conjunction with the limited refuse collection, Groot will provide collection of one (1) bulk item on a weekly basis which does not exceed fifty (50) pounds. Bulk items are defined as large household items which one person can lift such as sofas, dressers, chairs, tables, metal, lumber products and machine parts.

Appliances: White goods such as: refrigerators, freezers, ovens, washers, air conditioners, humidifiers, dehumidifiers, dryers, water heaters, water softeners, dishwashers, stoves, ranges, furnaces, etc. require a special pick-up and separate disposal is required by the state. Residents must call Groot at 847-693-2700 at least 24 hours in advance of their service day to schedule a pick up.

Holidays Observed:

New Years Day Labor Day Thanksgiving Day Memorial Day Christmas Dav 4th of July

In the event that a collection day falls on a holiday, collection for the remainder of the week will be provided one day late. If a Holiday falls on a Sunday, Monday will be an off day with service delayed one day the remainder of the week.
