TRUSTEE SHARON BOWER - ADMINISTRATION, FINANCE, JUDICIARY, LICENSING

<u>Bower/Skinner motion to approve a contract with Municipal Code Enforcement LLC for Code Enforcement.</u>
The contract will run from April to December of 2024. <u>Motion carried 6-0.</u>

TRUSTEE KEVIN FITZGERALD - STREETS & ROADS, EQUIPMENT, STREET LIGHTS, WEEDS, LAKE PLANNING AND PROTECTION

Skinner/Andres motion to approve the submittal of the Annual Report and other compliance documents for the Municipal Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit.

<u>Bower/Skinner motion to approve a quote from SJE for a soft starter pump at Lift Station #5.</u>
Greg Droessler explained that a soft starter is a mechanism enabling the pump to start without drawing excessive electricity from the area. It prevents the heavy load from being hit all at once. The starter is not directly related to the pump but rather sits in the electrical lineup, supplying power to the motor as part of the power system. <u>Motion carried 6-0.</u>
